- · Wrong resident
- Incorrect amount of drug
- · Wrong delivery of drug
- Drug administered incorrect times
- · Drug stored improperly
- Incorrect tools used to administer drugs
- Drugs labeled improperly
- Doctors' orders not followed correctly
- · Wrong drug is prescribed
- Failure to recognize drug interactions
- Failure to recognize allergic reactions
