On the above date and time I was dispatched to 601 Coleman St Hapeville Fulton County Ga in reference to information to an officer. Upon my arrival I spoke to complainant facility manager Higgins. Higgins advised one of her patients/victim Stafford was abuse while in care of a former employee Thomas. Stafford was left at Hapeville Manor on Dec. 27, 2018 - Jan. 2, 2019 for overnight care. An employee by the name of Whitley Brown wrote an incident report on Jan. 1, 2019 advising Stafford had a bruise on her face from her glasses. Stafford was taken home by her son Moore on Jan 2, 2019 and he noticed more bruises on his mother that appear to be cigarette burns. Moore bought the bruises to Higgins's attention.

Higgins advised Britney Thomas was the only employee on shift Dec. 31, 2018 caring for Stafford overnight. Higgins also advised Thomas is the only employee on staff who smokes. Higgins advised she believes Thomas is the one who burned Stafford. Management advised when Thomas was confronted about the incident she became angry and stated "that lady is hard to deal with, and she is like a vegetable." Higgins advised Thomas denied she did anything to Stafford.

Higgins advised both Thomas and Brown were fired because of the incident. I observed and took photographs of Stafford's burns and attached to this report along with Brown's incident report and Thomas time card which puts her at the facility the night before the incident report was wrote. Nothing further.
