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Zantac Case Criteria

Threshold Exposure

For typical case:

- At least 1 year of Zantac (ranitidine) exposure prior to cancer diagnosis
- Minimum of 300 mg / week during 1 year period of exposure
- No more than 5 years since last Zantac (ranitidine) exposure prior to cancer diagnosis

For prenatal exposure case:

- At least 6 months of exposure to Zantac (ranitidine) exposure during pregnancy
- Minimum of 300 mg / week during 6-month period of exposure
- No more than 5 years after birth for diagnosis of cancer

For pediatric exposure case:

- At least 6 months of Zantac (ranitidine) exposure prior to cancer diagnosis
- Minimum of 150 mg / week during 6-month period of exposure
- No more than 1 year since last Zantac (ranitidine) exposure prior to cancer diagnosis

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
